Barbecue Rules

Barbecuing is permitted only in designated areas (see map inside). Barbecuing is prohibited in all other areas of Prospect Park.

- Use a charcoal grill or hibachi at least two feet above the ground.
- Propane is not permitted; charcoal only.
- Keep grills 10 feet from trees or structures.
- Groups of 20 or more require a permit. For permits, visit prospectpark.org/permits. Or call (718) 965-8944.

Barbecue Clean-Up

- Do not place coals on ground.
- Deposit coals in hot coal bins, or
- Extinguish coals with water and wrap coals in foil. Place wrapped coals in a dumpster, or leave them in or next to a trash can.
- Please bag all other trash and place in a dumpster or carry out of the park..
